

The Journey from Galway to Carndonagh will take about 4 hours.

For those traveling straight up the morning of the wedding, you might be tempted to stop in Sligo. However, Sligo is a wee bit early to stop as its still 2 hours twenty minutes to Carndonagh, so I'd recommend stopping further up the road.

I'd really advise sticking to main national primary roads the whole way. Most towns are bypassed with the exception of Ballybofey, which can be busy as you go through the main street. Because of all the bypasses, there are numerous roundabouts. Be cautious with the roundabouts as it is easy to go wrong.

Going onwards from Letterkenny, when you come off the dual carriageway, there is a roundabout (Bridgend Roundabout). You will take the first exit there (veering left) and then you have two options. To come the route via Buncrana or come the route via Muff.

Both are probably similar timewise, the Buncranna way would be handier if anyone is going to the hotel first, while going via Muff is more scenic as you will drive alongside the Foyle, it is also the more natural way to go to Carndonagh (where church is).

Sligo is a great stop on the way home from the wedding as the lions share of the journey is over and its only 1hour 30mins to Galway.
