

## **Ballyliffin Beach**

Ballyliffin Beech known also as Pollan Bay. The horizon is very beautiful and there is a grassy path at the top of the beach which is great for walking/running.

The beech itself can be stoney and steep. It can be very windy and wild but very refreshing & pretty. (3min drive from Ballyliffin)



Tullagh Strand is one long stretch of white soft sand. It is a beautiful horseshoe shaped beach with soft sand and crystal-clear water.

Tullagh Strand is very near to Hotel. (9min drive from Ballyliffin)



#### **Culdaff Beach:**

Culdaff Beach is our favorate beach in Donegal. Unspoilt. quiet. Stunning. Peaceful. One long stretch of golden sand, stunning views. Over a wee fishing harbour. Well worth a visit.

## Lagg beach/ Five Finger Strand:

Lagg beach is not as long a walk, as other beaches are but it has a beautiful backdrop with cliffs/mountains & huge sand dunes. It is on the way to Malin head and has a very pretty drive out to it.

## **Dough Strand:**

Donagh Strand is the beach opposite Lagg, so again very beautiful and sandy. The sand is very soft however the tide (8 mins drive from the hotel)



### **Kinnego Bay:**

Kinnego Bay is mentioned by Lonely Planet On their international list of the nicest beaches to visit. It is really tricky to access with a dramatic winding incline but has beautiful golden sand, is very sheltered and secluded (30mins drive from the hotel)
